- 3 gun venue
pistol/carbine/shotgun



Firearms used in Action (URBAN) are:

Any Modern Semi Auto Pistol or Double Action Revolver. (.22 - 45cal.)
(Four magazines or speed loaders are needed)

Any Semi Auto or Pump Shotgun.
(Capable of holding 4 Or more shells in the tube)

Any Pistol Caliber Semi Auto or Lever Action Carbine (Rifle) Capable of Holding Ten (10) Rounds.

(This is for the Optional Carbine or Texas Ranger Class)

Any Optics or External Modifications may put the Shooter in the "Open Class".

Ammunition used in Action (URBAN) are:

Pistol: Lead or hard cast bullets at minimum velocities are preferred. If these are not available then standard 'cheap' ball or round nose bullets are acceptable.

***High velocity, hollow point and plus P ammunition are banned.**

Shotgun: Low brass 7 1/2 shot or smaller (#8, #9 etc) are acceptable.

***Slugs or high brass shells are banned.**

Carbine (Rifle): Lead or hard cast bullets at minimum velocities are preferred. If this is not available then standard 'cheap' ball or round nose bullets are acceptable.

***High velocity, hollow point and plus P ammunition are banned. REMEMBER: You must use flat nose bullets in tubular magazines.**

REQUIRED ITEMS

- o 150+ rounds of pistol ammo
- o 30+ rounds of shotgun ammo
- o 60+ rounds of carbine (rifle) ammo
- o 4 Magazine or Speedloaders
- o Holster, Belt, Magazine/Speedloader Pouches
(HOLSTER MUST COVER THE TRIGGER AND RETAIN PISTOL DURING NORMAL ACTIVITIES)
- o Eye & Ear Protection
(Eye protection must have side protection)

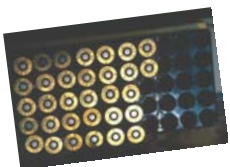
